The SEN and Disability Act 2001 extended the Disability Discrimination Act 1995 (DOA) to cover education. Since September 2002, the Governing Board has had three key duties towards disabled pupils, under Part 4 of the DOA:

- 1. Not to treat disabled pupils less favourably for a reason related to their disability.
- 2. To make reasonable adjustments for disabled pupils, so that they are not at a substantial disadvantage,
- 3. To plan to increase access to education for disabled pupils.

This plan sets out the proposals of the Governing Board of the Academy to ensure maximised access to education for disabled pupils in the

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- quired areas set out in the planning duties in the DOA, by:
- Increasing the extent to which disabled pupils can participate in the Academy curriculum.
- b) the environment of the Academy to increase the extent to which disabled pupils can take advantage of education and associations.
- c) Improving the elivery to disabled pupils of information, which is provided in writing for pupils who are not disabled.
